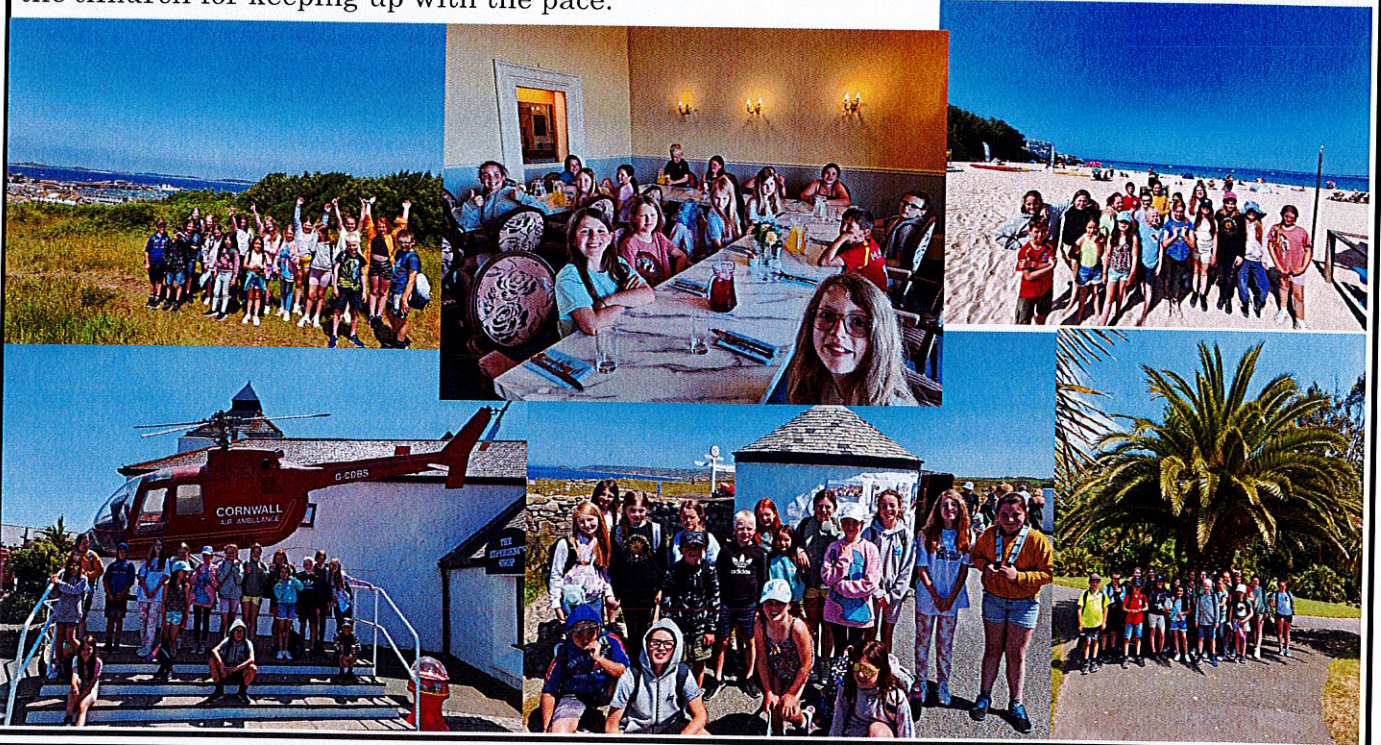
EQUALITY AND DIVERSITY
